
## "Extra" document to store writing

Institutions requiring publications for tenure are notoriously inflexible and RCM academic mothers attempting to juggle pregnancy(ies) and childcare and the workload of composition studies faculty members are at a clear time disadvantage. Time is exactly why the RCM study has implications for our discipline, and by extension, higher education as scholarly

productivity consists of a variety of factors including how much labor/time is put into creating scholarly work.
